## Biographical/Historical Note

Born Abba Louisa Goold in Windham, Maine in 1838, she married Moses Woolson in 1856. She taught literature and wrote essays for the *Home Journal*, *Portland Transcript* and *Boston Journal*. She was active in the movement toward ready-made clothing for women, as opposed to custom-made clothing, which took much time and effort, publishing *Dress-Reform* in 1874. She wrote several other books, including *George Eliot and Her Heroines*.
