Born in Presque Isle, Maine in 1870, Flora McGlauflin taught school in Brownville, Maine and met her husband (Alfred Searles) there. She published poems and stories in a paper titled *The Contributor* and sold one poem "The Old Man's Soliloquy" in booklet form in 1900. Her book *The Scarlet Ribbon* was published in 1900. She died in 1925.
