She has been a science education consultant for Bates College, a learning associate at Bates and Bowdoin, an instructor in the Lewiston Adult Education program, and a science consultant with the Hughs Science Outreach Grants program/Lewiston Public School Department. She has been a volunteer field botanist for the New England Wildflower Society since 1984; an educator for the Stanton Bird Club since 1986, spearheading monthly programs, trips, and the Junior Naturalist program; and steward of the 357-acre Thorncrag Nature Sanctuary since 1987.
