The catalogs series contains catalogs published by Westbrook Seminary, Westbrook Seminary and Junior College, Westbrook Junior College and Westbrook College 1844-1996. Each publication contains a variety of information useful to prospective students and their parents. This information includes the names of the Officers of the Corporation, Board of Trustees, Administrators, Teachers, and Students with their town of residence; Course of Study; textbooks used; calendar; a description of the facilities and student life; and tuition costs. No students are listed between the 1915/1916 school year and the 1935/1936 school year or after 1971/1972. Photographs of faculty, administrators, students, building interiors and exteriors, and sports teams appear from the 1915/1916 through 1932/1933 publications as well as 1955/1956 through 1995/1996.
